GOOD NEWS JAIL MINISTRY



We welcome Chaplain Joe Collins! He is a native of Bristol, VA and a graduate of Belmont University in Nashville, TN. Joe served as pastor at First Baptist Church, Charlotte, TN before becoming a chaplain with GNJPM in January 1997. He served as Chaplain for Dickson County Sheriff Department until May 2001. Then Joe transferred to Harrison County, MS to begin the ministry at the county detention center. In 2015 he transferred to Prince George, VA to begin the GNJPM at Riverside Regional Jail. On August 1, 2019, Joe came to Martinsville as Chaplain and lives in Henry County with his wife Becky. They have one son.
