- Raceway Ministries: Eight members of the team attended the Annual Meeting in Mount Juliet, TN in January. By using social media and websites, we heard how lives are being changed across the country as our national teams serve in Michigan, Indiana, California, Texas, the Carolinas, Virginia, and more.

- Good News Jail & Prison Ministry: Plans are being made for an expanded ministry of Prayer, Preaching, & Teaching in Henry County's new jail scheduled to open in late March. I hope to hold the first worship services on Easter Sunday. By year's end, I am planing to open an intensive discipleship program to address areas of known weakness with scripture. Also, I am launching a community wide Prayer Focus to cover the inmates and staff in the new jail with prayer.

As a Master Facilitator, I serve to coordinate expansion and training for trauma healing for our chaplains in the US and internationally. I am bringing Healing Heart Wounds bible study to Henry County to help inmates find healing in scripture for those wounds. There are trauma healing training's scheduled for this area with a view of expanding that ministry into area churches also.
