MISSION ACCOMPLISHED – In September, we joined with the Pittsylvania Baptist Association in Danville in collecting relief items for the flood victims in Whitesburg, KY. We received a great response from 8 of our churches!

- **Horne Home:** Ethel Flood, Manager since 2018, retired February 28^{tth,} with a total of 14 years with HopeTree. Brooke Smith is now Senior Manager of the Horne Home and also the Smith Home. Also, the process of transferring the deed of the Horne Home to HopeTree Family Services is still in progress.
- Raceway Ministries: Eight members of the team attended the Annual Meeting in Mount Juliet, TN in January. We served the April and October races at our ministry tent. We want to thank again the churches that donate snacks for each race. That helps make our Ministry possible. THANK YOU!
- **Operation Inasmuch:** The Executive Committee in January decided not to have this mission this year with the idea of having time to plan a larger scale mission event in 2023.
- Good News Jail & Prison Ministry: Henry County's new jail opened in late March, and is now known as "Henry County Adult Detention Center". The first worship service there was on Easter Sunday. An intensive discipleship program to address areas of known weakness with scripture has begun, and so has a community wide Prayer Focus to cover the inmates and staff with prayer. In December donations through December 31st to "Hope Packs" will be matched to double your gift. "Hope Packs" deliver a gift and the Gospel for Christmas to inmates. - Builders on Mission/Disaster Relief Team: In March a silent auction was held to sell the Disaster Relief trailer and included tools that had not been utilized in at least 11 years. The auction resulted in \$6526.00 earmarked for future missions. On November 12th, \$2000.00 of that was used to host a Christian concert by Melinda Nester Isley at FBC Collinsville.
 - At the Annual Meeting in October, it was approved to dissolve this team due to fact no one had volunteered in several years to serve. Hence, the sale of the trailer and tools.
- **WMU Team:** This team was also dissolved from the Association at the Annual Meeting. This team is it's own independent Mission.

CHURCH HEALTH GROUP

At our Annual Meeting in October, it was approved to streamline and combine our Community Connections & Celebration Group with our Church Health Group. This combination now consists of Church and Community Team, which includes Sunday School, Discipleship, and Evangelism. The Group also includes our Ministerial Well-Being, and Ordination Council teams.
